

ICJP Resolution on Israeli-Palestinian Negotiations

Done in Jerusalem, Israel, June 29, 2011:

Whereas the United Nations Security Council adopted resolution 242 affirming Israel's right to exist within secure and recognized boundaries, free from any threat or acts of force;

Whereas the United Nations Security Council resolution 338 and subsequent international agreements have affirmed direct negotiations as the framework for achieving peace in the Middle East;

Now therefore, be it resolved that

The International Council of Jewish Parliamentarians calls for direct negotiations between Israelis and Palestinians the ultimate goal being two states for two peoples - with recognition of Israel as a Jewish state and homeland for the Jewish people and the state of Palestine as the homeland of the Palestinian people.
